Grumpy Jim's Dates in History

The *Cornish Stannaries*, a *Cornish Parliament* of the time, were suspended in 1496 by Henry VII, who demanded £1000 to fund his war campaign against Scotland.

The *Cornish* people rebelled and marched with an army of 15,000. It arrived at London and fought the Kings Army in the battle of Deptford Bridge (Blackheath).

The *Cornish* army lacked experience and mistakes led to losing the war. The leaders were hanged and beheaded. Many *Cornish* were caught and enslaved.
