Grumpy Jim's Dates in History

Henry VII agreed to pardon those that took place in the rebellion of 1497, by writing a Charter of Pardon.

He said that no new laws affecting miners should be enacted without the consent of twenty-four stannators, six being chosen from each of the four stannaries.

These were Foweymore (chosen by the mayor and corporation of Lostwithiel), Blackmore (Launceston), Tywarnhaile (Truro) and Penwith and Kerrier (Helston).
